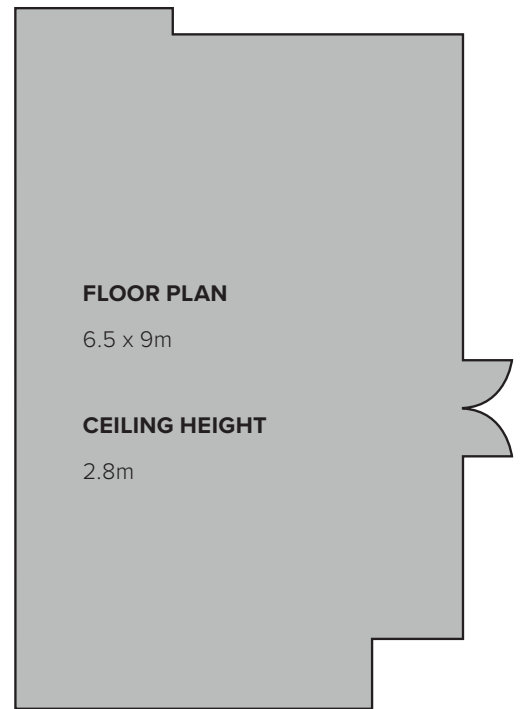

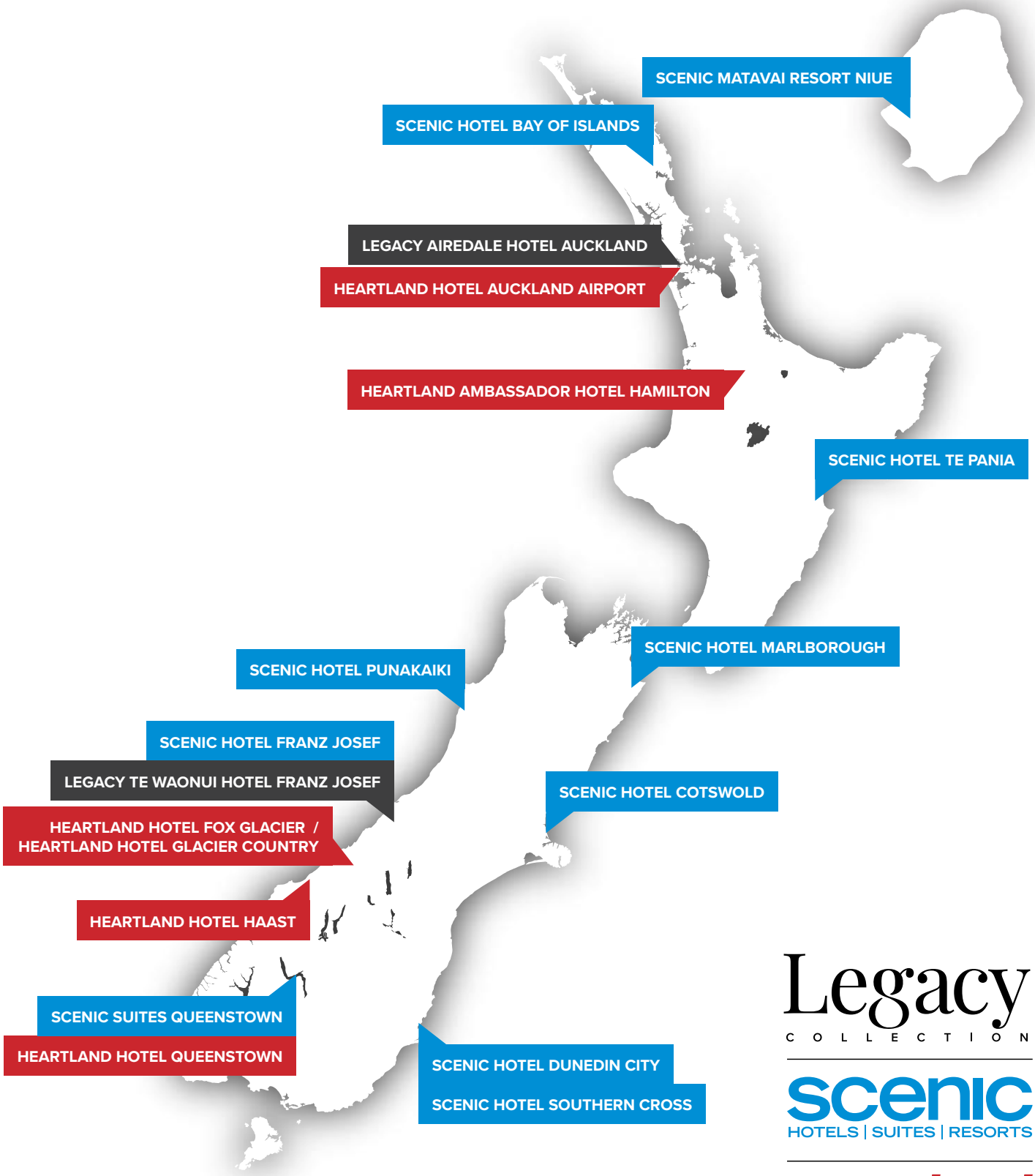
ACTIVITY DETAILS
