- Participate in local, national, and international discussions around environmental issues, including climate change.

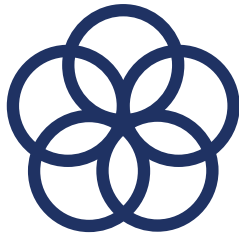
APPLICATION / SCOPE
